Call to Order:

Business:

- 1. Zoning Commission The board would like to put together a zoning commission.
- 2. Sewer Manhole on E Martin was overflowing after all the rain. DNR was called about it overflowing and running into creek. Clint Cross made mention that maintenance and repairs to help avoid these situations would be taken care of if we decided to connect with Moberly Sewer. Corner of Scott and Main also contacted DNR for same reasons. Manholes all down Prather Ave. are leaking storm water into the system.
- 3. Manhole, Resurface, & Road Sign on Linda Lane Megan Brumley made a motion to get bids to repair the manhole on Linda Lane and to get Linda Lane resurfaced where it was torn up to tie into that manhole. Vanessa Joseph seconded the motion. All were in favor and motion passed on a voice vote.
- 4. Scott Street Railroad still owns property and cars fly down road. Vanessa Joseph would like to look into closing the road off. It is used to deliver meals on wheels, which could cause issues for them. Need to call railroad to determine if we could potentially be fined for using road. Motion made by Vanessa Joseph to look into blocking Scott with concrete barriers. Megan seconded the motion. All were in favor and motion passed on a voice vote.
- 5. Lions Club Would like to sell alcohol during Pioneer Days from Lions Club building. They will carry the event insurance as usual. The board would like to give them permission. They have also invited the board to participate in the parade.
- 6. Snow Removal Bid The only bid obtained for snow removal after being posted in the Moberly Monitor Index was from C2 Excavating & Tree-B-Gone. The Village of Cairo Board reviewed the bid and a motion was made by Megan Brumley to accept the bid and auction all city equipment as discussed at June meeting. The motion was seconded by Vanessa Joseph and all voted in favor. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote
